Dairy breed improvement is necessary in Nigeria, especially because indigenous cows produce on average 2 litres per day. Foreign exchange regulations introduced by the Central Bank of Nigeria has restricted importations of milk and dairy products, thereby increasing the need to improve local dairy productivity through modern technology. The Real People Concept, through their Cattle Hub, are working with youth, women and smallholder farmers to raise annual incomes and productivity through about 500 hybrid heifers that can produce an average of 10 Litres of milk per day, using such technology interventions as artificial insemination.

We help smallholder farmers, animal scientist, veterinarians and other livestock production experts solve major problems of reproduction, multiplication & productivity in cattle Production. We are poised to drive Nigeria cattle productivity with modern technological solutions.
