Objectives:

- 1. To compare the genetic diversity of ancient and extant Ethiopian goats
- 2. To investigate the evolutionary history and relationships within and between Ethiopian modern goats and world goats using a published database
- 3. To identify whether extant Ethiopian goat breeds are descendants of the first introduced goats in Ethiopia
- 4. To estimate dispersal route(s) and timing of goat introduction to Ethiopia
- 5. To evaluate the genetic diversity and structure within and between Ethiopian goats
- 6. To identify genes responsible for the phenotypic variations (meat, milk and disease resconomically important genes of each breed
- 7. To evaluate adaptive genetic mechanisms of Ethiopian goats to different agro-ecologies and infections
