2020 Highlights

- Integration and coordination with activities of other CRP flagships
- Vaccination of SR for respiratory diseases (ovine pasteurellosis, PPR), incl. pre- and post vaccination seromonitoring
- Control of gastro-intestinal parasites
- Deworming of dogs to control coenurosis in SR
- Treatment and following up of sick animals
- Morbidity and mortality data recording at household level
- New community conversation modules
