















Background

- Leptospira: bacteria that cause leptospirosis, a zoonotic disease endemic in the tropics
- Annual global morbidity of about 1,000,000 cases

Gaps

- Livestock are implicated for human leptospirosis in Uganda
- Prevention and control requires understanding which livestock species are reservoirs, and how humans get infected


