- Support farmers to understand the effects of different agricultural practices and decisions on the performance of the enterprise

Our approach

- Development of tools for use in the Landscape scoping Exercise
- Gross Margin Training manual adaptation to Pig farming
- Development of GM Pictorial Farmer reference aid
- Training of extension Staff and Village Based Agents on GMC

- Understanding the concept of Gross Margin for Profitability
- Adoption of Record keeping
- Increased number of Beneficiaries (Introduction of new farmers)
- Improved livestock management (Health, feeding)
